St. Patrick's churchgoers are allowed to park on the Firestone Complete Auto Care property at 800 Camp St. during all of the weekend Masses, courtesy of Firestone.

The following regulations must be obeyed:

1. Park only in the designated spaces marked by **yellow lines**.
2. The handicapped marked zones are **never to be used**.
3. Do not park against or near the Firestone building.
4. Do not block the driveway or bay doors.
5. Your vehicle must be out of the lot after 30 minutes following the Mass, and by 7pm on Saturday.
6. Failure to comply with these regulations will result in your **vehicle being booted or towed to the auto pound at your expense.**

The Firestone Auto Care is not a commercial parking lot and it is imperative that they adhere to certain fire department regulations so as to fully protect their business property.

Let all of St. Patrick's churchgoers who take advantage of this generous courtesy be very careful in complying with their instructions.



To The Parishioners and Visitors of St. Patrick's Church:

After much consideration, we have relayed our concerns to our Corporate Office and they have agreed to allow mass attendees to park, once again, in our Parking Lot of the Firestone Complete Auto Care, located at 800 Camp Street. We do apologize for the upheaval and inconvenience this has caused to so many. This was not our intention! We ask that you park in a designated parking spot only. A vehicle cannot block our driveway or our bay doors at any time. Such would be a reason for a vehicle to be towed. This occurs quite often, and most likely not by those attending mass, but this is an instance of the "Good suffering for the Bad".

The Parish Administrator is in the process of printing out "mass parking passes" and these will be available either at the rectory or in the small waiting area when you walk into the church. We also ask that your vehicle does not remain in the lot after 30 minutes following mass. Those in the lot after 7 pm on Saturdays, are in danger of being towed.

This change was caused by the persistence of those on your Local Community Board.

We at Firestone welcome you back! Of course, there will always be times of restriction, such as: Mardi Gras; Special Events at the Dome or at the Convention Center. We hope you can understand and respect our reasons for such!
